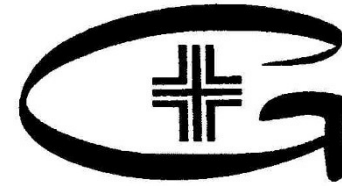
The office is in need of paper for large bulletins (11x17). Thanks for your help!
