There is a collection box on the ushers' table. Collect your change during the week and bring it in on Sunday. This month we will give your donations to the Lancaster Food Pantry.

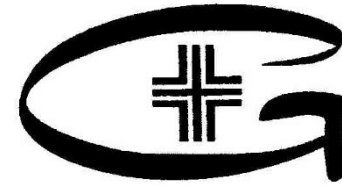

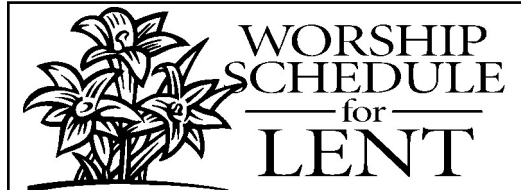
The Pickerington food pantry is in desperate need of cereal, canned pasta and fruit juice. Thank you for your support!
