The Pickerington Food Pantry is in desperate need of donations and volunteers. Volunteers are greatly needed as many of their regular volunteers have had to isolate during the pandemic. Currently they need volunteers to:

- Donate DIAPERS, especially in sizes 5 & 6 and pull-ups in any size.
- Help in the back room on Thursdays and Saturdays to prep for clients. Even help once a month is appreciated!
- Be the Back Room Boss: this role is for one (or more) Saturday morning a month summer. The back room (or delivery area) is the backbone of the pantry. The hours are 9:00 a.m. until 12:30. Please feel free to request more information. Lifting heavy boxes of donations is required.
- Unload the MidOhio delivery truck on the second Tuesday of every month (this does include heavy lifting).
- Donate reusable grocery bags, or even sturdy plastic ones
- Food/health care items are always welcome.
- Cash donations are also greatly appreciated!

For every dollar you donate, the pantry can purchase \$11 worth of food. So donations are appreciated.
