Dwayne R Spence Funeral Home is located at 550 Hill Rd. N., Pickerington. Fliers are available on the usher's table.

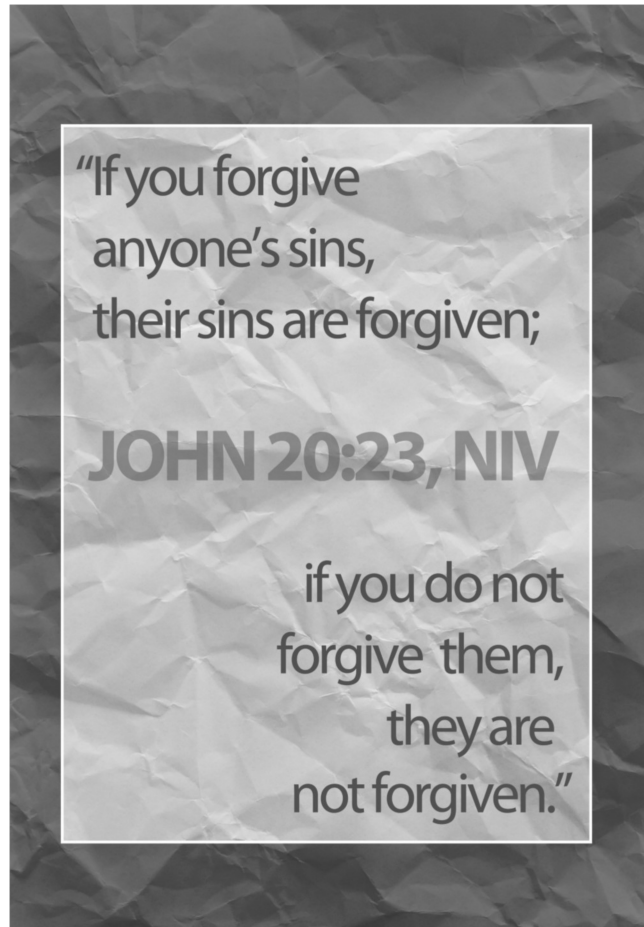
