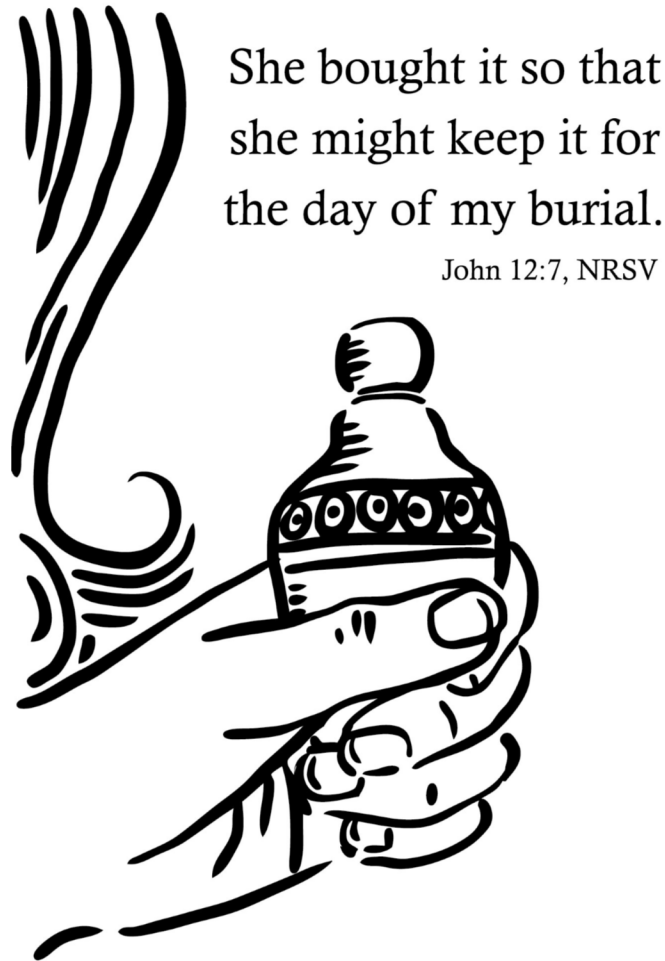


Women's Bible Study will be on November 20th this month at 9:30am.
